Teen Pregnancy Facts

In the U.S., close to one million teens get pregnant each year.

The U.S. has the highest teen pregnancy rate of all industrialized countries.

80% of teen pregnancies are not planned.

Half of all teen pregnancies happen within six months of their first time having sex.

Only 51% of teen moms earn a high school diploma.

The teen pregnancy rate is dropping in Oswego County, because teens are making healthy decisions.



As a result, fewer teens are becoming pregnant and those who do are having healthier births.

The APPS Project

CiTi APPS educators provide counseling and education on human sexuality, reproductive health issues and healthy relationships. They can also provide confidential pregnancy testing, referrals for reproductive health care and transportation with parent permission.

The mission of CiTi APPS Project is to coordinate the provision of high quality and innovative Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention and Services strategies for the residents of the county. Our intervention strategies will focus on the reduction of premature sexual activity and parenthood, which present potential long term medical, social, economic and psychological problems to adolescents, their families, the children they bear and society at large.

Teen Health Issues Educators

Questions about sex and sexuality are often embarrassing. Many teens receive their information from their friends, but friends don't always know or give the facts correctly, even though they are trying to help. Teen Health Issues Educators strive to correct this by providing confidential one-to-one education and counseling to teens and their families in Oswego County.
