The Emerging Skills Award was established in January 2021 with the support of Philip "Flip" Purvis. Mr. Purvis very successfully started and ran his company "Service with Purvis" for 35 years. "Service with Purvis" was primarily a construction company that serviced Oswego and surrounding areas. The intent of the award is to focus on students who attend class with a positive attitude, prepared to learn, and exhibit a strong work ethic. The award recipient will be recognized for showing a passion and knowledge of their craft and their dedication to hard work. This award is meant to recognize the most productive CTE students.

In accordance with the guidelines established by Board Resolution, a \$1,000 annual scholarship will be awarded to 3 worthy and needy CiTi students who meet the criteria of the selection committee.

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants must be a senior currently enrolled in a Career & Technical Education program at the Center for Instruction, Technology, & Innovation, as well as have been previously recognized as "Most Employable Student of the Month" and/or been recognized as a "Top 3" student.

Instructions to the Applicants:

Finalists for the Emerging Skills Award will be selected based on the successful completion of the application. Applicants may be required to participate in an interview.
