The Spike Nolan "Making a Difference" Scholarship was established in the spring of 2017 in memory of Floyd "Spike" Nolan who was an instructor at Oswego County BOCES and taught Small Engines for more than twenty years. Spike was a strong advocate for students to strive for the best of their ability.

The intent of the scholarship is to improve the opportunities for CiTi students with strong entrepreneurial aspirations, plans for secondary education or self-improvement.

In accordance with the guidelines established by Board Resolution, two annual scholarships shall be awarded to a worthy and needy CiTi student who meets the criteria of the selection committee. Selection shall be made from the applications, personal interviews, and the letters of recommendation.

Eligibility Criteria: This scholarship is available to any currently enrolled CiTi CTE student, regardless of program.

The scholarship awards \$1000 payable to the recipient.
