





The CRYOMECH and Liverpool Turkey Trot Scholarship was established in the fall of 2019. The intention is to focus on students who have or will make a difference in the fields offered at CiTi BOCES (CTE, P-TECH, Work Study).

The intent of the scholarship is to reward and recognize students who show passion and knowledge of their craft, leadership qualities and possesses a strong work ethic. This award will shine the light on our most productive students within the above programs.

In accordance with the guidelines established by Board Resolution, two annual scholarships shall be awarded to a worthy **Junior** or **Senior** CTE, P-TECH, Work Study students who meets the criteria of the selection committee. Selection shall be made from the applications, personal interviews and the letters of recommendation.

**Eligibility Criteria**: This scholarship is available to any currently enrolled CTE, P-TECH, Work Study student, regardless of program.

The scholarship awards \$500 to \$3000 payable to the recipient.

#### Instructions to the Applicants

Finalists for the **CRYOMECH** Career & Technology Scholarship shall be selected based on the successful completion of the application procedures.

All written materials submitted for this scholarship are to be returned to the CTE Student Services Office by **Wednesday May 27th, 2020.** 

Applicants must submit the following:

- 1. A completed Scholarship Profile.
- 2. Two Letters of Recommendation from the applicant's CiTi instructor, Work Study representative, home schoolteacher, counselor, or employer.

All aplications will be reviewed by the CRYOMECH CTE, P-TECH, Work Study Scholarship Committee.

Finalists may be required to participate in an interview.
