

CiTi Reopening Plan Summary

Updated 1.14.21

The purpose of the plan is to offer some certainty during uncertainty, protocols that will be used to keep the children and adults in our schools safe for to face-to-face learning and measures that will be taken to ensure all students receive the education they are each entitled to via remote learning when necessary.---

CiTi-wide:

- Classrooms will be arranged to ensure 6 ft. distance between all persons, unless safety or core function of the work activity requires shorter distance.
- Barriers will be installed in areas with frequent close person-to-person contact.
- Acceptable face coverings must be worn by staff and students at all times except in the following situations: to eat or drink, during mask breaks, when outside and socially distant or during certain shop situations such as when someone is donning a welding helmet.
- CiTi will provide acceptable face coverings at no cost for individuals who do not have their own PPE.
- All students will be provided scheduled mask breaks throughout the day as needed based on physical, emotional and disability-specific needs.
- Anyone entering CiTi locations will be screened (except students arriving via district transportation who will be assumed that students admitted on the bus have been properly screened). If an individual presents a temperature greater than 100 degrees, the individual will be denied entry to the facility and given recommendation to see a healthcare provider to be tested for possible COVID-19 infection. If the student requires transportation, they will be sent to a dedicated isolation area prior to being picked up.
- Staggered arrival and dismissal times will be utilized when necessary to limit traffic flow.
- CiTi will support the social-emotional well-being of students and staff through mental health support services, mindfulness professional development and EAP for staff.
